

Directions to Butler County Government Offices

The Department of Development offices (Building & Zoning, Planning, Community Development, and Economic Development) are located in the Butler County Administrative Center, **130 High Street in downtown Hamilton, Ohio.**

The Administrative Center is on the north side of High Street, between Front and Second Streets, across from the Historic Butler County Courthouse. Metered parking is available on High Street or in the Market Street parking lot directly behind the Administrative Center.





Regular meetings of the Butler County Planning Commission, Rural Zoning Commission, and Board of Zoning Appeals are held on the ground floor of the Government Services Center, 315 High Street in downtown Hamilton, Ohio.

The Government Services Center sits on the south side of High Street at Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (US-127), two blocks east of the Administrative Center. Parking is available in the Court Street Garage just south of the GSC; a covered walkway connects the two buildings.

Local transit services in Hamilton are provided by the [Butler County Regional Transit Authority](#).

Three Regional bus routes serve Downtown Hamilton and the Butler County government offices on High Street. These routes also connect with Cincinnati's [METRO Bus System](#) at the Fairfield Crossings Park & Ride in Fairfield and Tri-County Mall in Springdale.
