

## GE Aviation

West Chester Township

With the construction on the new General Electric Aviation office campus nearly complete, GE is preparing to move the workforce behind its \$13.2 billion operation into the new campus in West Chester Township.

The \$55 million campus is located at the site of the former Queen City Sports Complex at the intersection of Cincinnati-Dayton Road and Union Center Boulevard. Two new buildings, built by Duke Construction and totaling 400,000 square feet, will become home to nearly 1,400 employees. County commissioners approved a 100%, 15-year property tax abatement for the new complex. The land is also under a Joint Economic Development District with the City of Fairfield and the City of Springdale, providing income tax revenue for the two cities as well as West Chester Township.
