St. Clair Township Invites Public to Share Opinions on December 8

St. Clair Township Trustees are inviting citizens to share their opinions about a plan for future development in the township at a public open house scheduled for Monday, December 8 from 5-7 p.m. in the Township Community Center, 2488 Summit Street, Overpeck. The public open house is intended to gain input about the township's future and will feature displays, presentations, and free refreshments.

The township has drafted a comprehensive plan to deal with growth and development over the next 20 years and the value of water resources upon which township residents, landowners, and businesses rely. This comprehensive plan is unique for including a component specifically for drinking water protection, especially significant in St. Clair Township where the high quality of water resources has attracted several public water suppliers as well as the Miller Brewing Company.

The planning project has involved funding assistance from the Miami Conservancy District and staff assistance to the township from the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments, the Butler County Planning Commission, and the Hamilton to New Baltimore Groundwater Consortium. Completion of the project is expected in the spring of 2009.
